


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


# Past-Year Alcohol Dependence or Abuse in Individuals 12 or Older




# Past-Year Illicit Drug Dependence or Abuse in Individuals 12 or Older




# Substance Use Problems in Individuals Enrolled in Substance Use Treatment in Nevada: Single-Day Counts




- ☞ 36.5% were in treatment for Drug use only
- ☞ 19.5% were in treatment for Alcohol use only
- ☞ 44.1% were in treatment for both Drug and Alcohol use

# Individuals Enrolled in Opioid Treatment Programs in Nevada Receiving Methadone: Single-Day Counts




# Individuals Enrolled in Substance Use Treatment Programs in Nevada Receiving Buprenorphine: Single-Day Counts



- ❧ 1,491 individuals were receiving methadone as part of their substance use treatment, and 75 were receiving buprenorphine
- ❧ The number of individuals receiving buprenorphine in Nevada was 121 in 2011
- ❧ The number of individuals in Nevada who received buprenorphine as part of their substance use treatment increased from 2009 to 2013

Age-adjusted rate


 Statistically unreliable

Age-adjusted rate


